Prior General's Circular NOTIFICATION OF XXXIX ORDINARY GENERAL SYNAXIS 2026

Reverend and Dear Fathers and Brothers,

Prayerful Greetings from CMI Prior General's House, Chavara Hills, Kakkanad!

In Consultation with the Major Superiors (27-29 September, 2025 at CMI Prior General's House, Kakkanad) and with the consent of the General Council (GCA 98/1616/2025, dated 25 September, 2025), I am happy to announce the schedule of the XXXIX General Synaxis along with the following guidelines for its effective and fruitful celebration.

1. Celebration of XXXIX Ordinary General Synaxis

The Ordinary General Synaxis is the supreme authority of a religious Congregation, and its celebration is a blessed time for the Congregation. At a time when the whole Church has gone through a synodal process, the General Synaxis is the best expression of it, where the Holy Spirit actively becomes present in the communion of the Body of Christ and in the missionary journey of our Congregation. The XXXIX Ordinary General Synaxis takes place as we prepare to celebrate the Bicentennial of our Congregation. It is an acceptable time (Kairos) to reaffirm our commitment to God the Father through Christ in his Church and to achieve a radical renewal of our consecrated life. The General Plenary Assembly in January 2025, the Provincial Plenary Assemblies, and the renewal program that has taken place in our Congregation are all aimed at facilitating the renewal of our consecrated life, which finds its culmination in this Ordinary General Synaxis.

It is natural that our human frailty and the ever-tempting attractions of our times cast shadows on our initial enthusiasm. Naturally, a spirit of compromise and an attitude to restrict ourselves to the comfort zones of life can creep into our routine life. Therefore, the Ordinary General Synaxis is a Pentecostal experience for the entire congregation, where we pray like the psalmist: "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me" (Psalm 51:10). It is an act of listening to the whispering of the Holy Spirit as a

community, enabling us to be renewed in Christ. "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here" (2 Cor 5:17).

The same Spirit which spoke to our founding fathers continues to speak to us. The Ordinary General Synaxis is a time to listen to this Spirit and to discern the right path in changed situations of our life, finding correct orientations to be relevant in serving God and His people. It is an occasion to make a periodical reflection on the charism of our Congregation, to take new steps and measures in the light of the evaluation of the past years, and to elect a new administration to animate our community for the next six years, facilitating our immediate preparations for the Bicentennial of our Congregation. I, therefore, wholeheartedly invite all our members to involve actively in the preparation and celebration of the XXXIX Ordinary General Synaxis.

The XXXIX Ordinary General Synaxis will be held during 15-21 March, 2026. The Synaxis commences with the Holy Qurbana.

2. Delegates to the General Synaxis

The delegates to the General Synaxis are both ex-officio and elected. The ex-officio delegates are the Prior General, General Councillors, General Auditor, and Provincials (C 172 a). The number of elected delegates to the General Synaxis shall be as per the CMI Directory Article 192 b and c. The Procurator General attends the General Synaxis without vote (D 192 e).

The Provincials shall send the list of elected delegates to the General Synaxis so as to reach the Prior General on or before 20 January, 2026.

3. Preparations for the General Synaxis

The celebration of an Ordinary General Synaxis is a significant moment in the life of the Congregation. Its goal is to protect the patrimony of the Congregation, to promote its continuing progress and renewal according to its charism and mission (suited to the needs of the times), to treat matters of major importance, to promulgate appropriate decrees, and to elect a new general government. To prepare for this important moment in the life of our Congregation, I request all members to reread the relevant sections of the CMI Constitutions and Directory on the Synaxes. I encourage that this review be held, wherever possible, in common, in local or zonal communities. I particularly enjoin on all that they participate in the study and discussions with seriousness, and present the

observations and proposals which they, before the Lord, believe are necessary for the wellbeing of the Congregation. The General Synaxis is the responsibility of everyone, not just the delegates to Synaxis. It is a gathering of the whole Congregation in faith, hope, and great love as we commit ourselves to live with renewed zeal and enthusiasm the charism that we have inherited from our founding fathers.

4. Synaxis Preparation Committee

In order to assist the General Council in the preparation of the XXXIX Ordinary General Synaxis, a Synaxis Preparation Committee has been constituted (Ref: GCA 88/1330/2025, dated 09 January, 2025) with the following members:

The main task of the Synaxis Preparation Committee will be the preparation of the *Lineamenta* ("Guidelines") and *Instrumentum Laboris* ("Working Document") of the General Synaxis.

They shall be the tools for our personal and collective study and deliberation at different levels. The Lineamenta will be prepared incorporating the suggestions of the General Plenary Assembly and the Qualitative Survey that was conducted about our Religious Life in the Congregation by a team headed by Fr Sony Palathra CMI. The Provincials shall coordinate and monitor the study and discussion of the Lineamenta in their respective Provinces with the help of a Provincial Coordinating Committee. The committee shall then summarize the observations and suggestions and submit a report to the General Secretariat on or before 01 January, 2026. With the assistance of the Synaxis Preparation Committee, the responses will then be attentively analysed and integrated into the Instrumentum Laboris.

5. Committee for Proposing Amendments to the Constitution and Directory

A Committee has been constituted, in consultation with the Major Superiors and with the consent of the General Council (Ref: GCA 88/1329/2025, dated 09 January, 2025), to identify those provisions of the Constitutions and Directory which call for change or

modifications along with new additions according to the changing context of our Religious Life and apostolates. The members of the committee are the following;

6. Petitions to the General Synaxis

All petitions to the General Synaxis, including individual/local/zonal responses to the Instrumentum Laboris, should reach the President of the General Synaxis on or before 06 March, 2026.

7. The Provincial Synaxes

- 1. The Provincials are requested to issue circulars regarding the constitution of the Provincial Synaxes and the election of delegates to the General/ Provincial Synaxes, observing the time schedule given below (Refer D 258).
- 2. Sample of Election Materials to be reached at the Generalate: 20 October, 2025
- 3. Notification of Fr Provincial regarding the election of delegates to the General/Provincial Synaxes: 01 November, 2025
- 4. Declaration of the list of delegates to the General/Provincial Synaxis: 08 January, 2026.
- 5. The election of the panel for the Prior General shall be done as per the direction given in D 281.
- 6. The new priests to be ordained in 2025-26 shall not be included in the voters' list as they will be given patent of local ascription only in January, 2026.
- 7. The Provincials are requested to give clear and definite instructions regarding elections in the notification circular in accordance with D 258-288
- 8. The Provincial Synaxis shall be planned by the Provincial Council in such a way that a proper evaluation of our Religious Life and apostolates will be done in the Synaxis along with the planning for the future in the light of the thrusts proposed by the General Synaxis.
- 9. The delegates to the Provincial Synaxis shall be elected as per the provisions in D 262 c (ii): "The required number of votes to be marked in the three seniority-wise constituencies shall be in the ratio of 1:1:1 of the 75% of the vacancies of the total number of vacancies (after deducting the number of brother delegates to be

- elected). The remaining 25% shall be marked without considering the constituencies."
- 10. The following shall be the schedule for the First Session of the Provincial Synaxes for the evaluation and planning on the various aspects of religious life and apostolates in each Province, followed by the election of the Provincial, Councillors, and Auditor:

- 12. The election of the Provincial shall be preceded by a half-day prayer.
- 13. The Provincials are requested to send the following materials to the Prior General for information:
 - a. Samples of the election materials described in D 260 (on or before 20 October, 2025).
 - b. List of delegates elected to the Provincial Synaxis along with the substitution list (on or before **20 January**, **2026**).
