Appendix 1

LITURGICAL SEASONS

Seasons of Annunciation - Nativity

The liturgical year of the Syro-Malabar Church begins with the period of Annunciation. The four weeks in preparation to the feast of the Nativity of Jesus, celebrated on 25th December constitute this season. Since we practise abstinence from 1st to 25th December in preparation for Christmas, we call this period "25 days Lent"

Season of Epiphany

The word Epiphany in Syriac is known as 'Denha'. It means 'dawn' 'revelation' 'manifestation' etc. In this season, the Church recalls the manifestation of Jesus which began with his baptism at Jordan. Jesus reveals Himself to the world; Father and the Holy Spirit witness to it.

Season of Lent

The passion, death and resurrection of Jesus mark the climax of His salvific acts. The seven weeks between Denha and the feast of Easter are set apart for prayer, fasting, abstinence and reparation. The basis of this lenten season is the forty days fast of Jesus. Still, we call this period 'Anpathu Nombu' (50 days' fasting).

Season of Resurrection

The Season of Resurrection consists of seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost. The resurrection of Christ is as a pledge of our resurrection. His resurrection is as a basis of Christian faith etc.

Season of Apostles

Pentecost is a feast intimately connected with the history of salvation. The term 'Pentecost' means 'fifty' - the feast on the fiftieth day. It was a feast of first fruit connected with the harvest. Later this feast turned out to be the commemoration of the covenant by which the Israelites became the people of God.

Season of Kaitha

This season commences commemorating the twelve apostles of Christ. The term 'Kaitha' means summer. It is the season of harvest. This season reminds us of the growth of the Church as a result of the mission- ary activity of the apostles. It can be seen also as a preparation to the season of Elijah- Cross- Moses that points to the second coming of our Lord. It directs us to the need of repentance and conversion

Season of Elijah - Cross - Moses

This season points to the second coming of our Lord and the ultimate success of the cross. The central point of this period is the feast of the Exaltation of the Cross celebrated on 14th September. The transfiguration of Jesus is a symbol of His second coming.

Seasons of Dedication of the Church and Annunciation

The last four weeks of the liturgical year belong to this season. It is a foretaste of the eternal bliss to come.

Appendix 2

FEASTS

The readings of the Sundays and other important days are given in the Calendar as per the direction of the *Supplementum Mysteriorum* and *Ordo* published by Rome in 1959 -'60. The feasts are divided according to their importance in the Syro-Malabar Church. The readings have been arranged accordingly.

In the first category, we have the feasts of Our Lord and Blessed Virgin Mary who are directly connected with the mystery of salvation and certain other important feasts of the Church (e.g. Christmas, Easter, Immaculate Conception of Bl. V. Mary, *Dukrana* (the feast of St. Thomas), St.Kuriakose Elias Chavara, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. On these festal days, the readings of the particular feasts are given first.

In the second category, the popular feasts of the saints commonly commemorated in our church are given (e.g. St. Antony of Paduva, St. Sebastian, St. Francis Assisi, etc). On these days, the readings of the feasts are given after the readings of the day.

If the feast of Denha occurs on Sunday, then it will be considered as the first Sunday of Denha. When the feast of Denha comes on Sunday to Thursday, then these days would be counted as the first week of Denha. However, if it happens to be on Friday, the readings of the following Saturday would be the same of the first Saturday of Denha and the following Sunday as its First Sunday. The commemoration of all the departed can be celebrated either on the last Friday of the Period of Epiphany or on 2nd November. The fasting and the penitential service for the preparation of the Great Lent are celebrated on the first Monday of Great Lent. If necessary, it can be celebrated on another day of Great Lent with the permission of the local ordinary.

On the day of penitential service marking the beginning of Great Lent and on Passion Friday, fasting and abstinence are to be observed. It is desirable to fast on every Friday of the season of Great Lent. All Fridays throughout the year are days of abstinence except the Fridays between Christmas and the feast of Epiphany, and the first Friday after Easter.
